# WASTE DISPOSAL INFORMATION

## Garden Waste

Subscribe to our Garden Waste Scheme. Collections are fortnightly. They start in July, but do **NOT** take place in December, January and February and then resume in March.

## Bulky Waste Collection

Items such as furniture (beds, sofas) and white goods (washing machines, cookers, fridges and freezers) can

be removed as part of our Bulky Household Waste Collection Service. We also provide a collection service for DIY items such as doors, bathroom suites, kitchen units, bags of household waste, timber, bricks and rubble for both domestic and commercial customers. **There is a charge for this.** Find out more here: [www.pendle.gov.uk/bulkywaste](http://www.pendle.gov.uk/bulkywaste) Use your local Household Waste Recycling Centre to dispose of a wide range of materials, including electronic equipment and furniture. ## COMING APRIL 2026

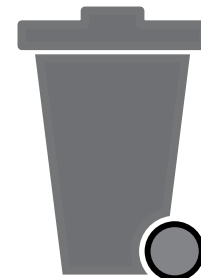
**A WEEKLY food waste collection service is to be introduced on 1 April 2026.**

All Pendle residents will be required to separate their food waste from other waste and put it in a food waste bin for collection. Each household will be provided with a 23-litre outdoor caddy and a 5-litre indoor caddy. **Distribution of the caddies will start at the beginning of February and be completed by the end of March.**

## VAPES & E-CIGS

**DO NOT** dispose of used vapes and e-cigs in your waste bins. Take them to your local Household Waste Recycling Centre.



## HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES ONLY

Put used batteries in a clear plastic bag and leave **ON TOP OF THE LID OF YOUR BLUE or BROWN RECYCLING BIN** on your recycling day.
